

Planting Day with the Sherbrooke Community School

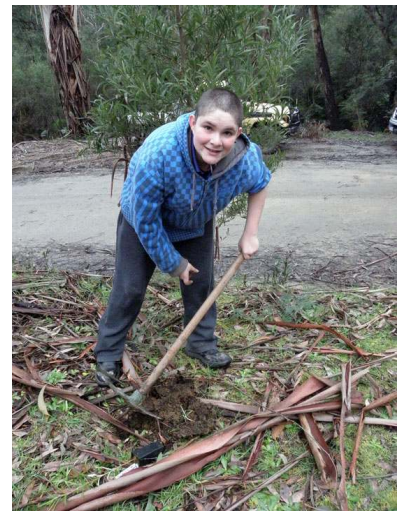
Thursday 2 September 2010

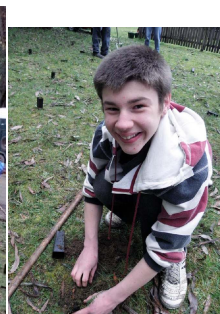
